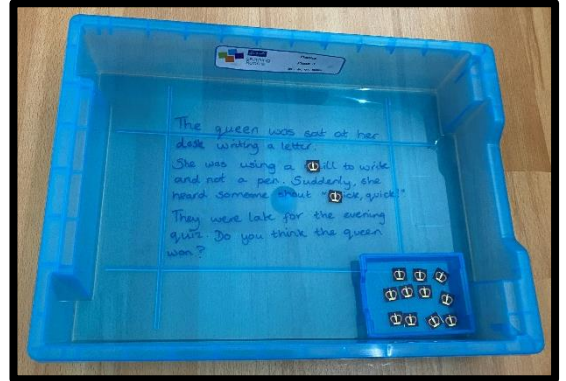


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What's in my tray?

Phonics

Phonics- Phase 3- 'qu'- qu, qu, queen



What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- Downloadable stamp image
- Whiteboard pen
- Blu-tack

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

1. Label the tray using the downloadable label.
2. Write a simple phoneme spotter in the base of the tray that has words with the 'qu' sound.
3. Print and cut out the stamps and place in a separate pot.

What to do: (child)

1. Ask the child to read the story as best they can. Offer support where necessary.
2. As they read, they need to look out for words with the 'qu' sound.
3. Encourage them to say 'qu, qu, queen' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
4. When they have identified a word, place a stamp on the 'qu' sound and continue to read on.

Differentiation:

Easier:

Have a selection of words written in the tray instead of a long phoneme spotter.

Harder:

Which words have they heard before that have the 'qu' sound?
